(i) Process of decision making Identify key decision making points	Proposal are moved from PC Unit which are routed through the following hierarchy: Assistant Incharge AF&AO AO Director
(ii) Final decision making authority	Director
(iii) Related provisions, acts, rules etc.	As per ICAR guidelines time to time
(iv) Time limit for taking a decisions, if any	There is no specific time limit, however, decisions are taken keeping in view of time limit either prescribed by the ICAR or in shortest possible time in interest of the Project.
(v) Channel of supervision and accountability	Annual and biennial group meetings are conducted to review the progress of the coordinating centres. Besides this five yearly review of research work is done by QRT committee constituted by the ICAR. In ever financial year monitoring of funds transactions are done by internal and external audit parties appointed by the ICAR.
